

## \*Selling 7 bred heifers, 8 open heifers, 1 bull calf\*

### Lot 1 – GG35X – polled fullblood Bn March 2

This may be the fullblood heifer of the year. The first calf to sell from the new French bull, Sultan. Here is a calf that is as long as they come, polled and carries a butt on her. She could easily become one of the best polled fullblood cows to raise breeding stock from. Her dam, GG38M (Sire Polled Perfection), has paid her way with many good calves. We are using a polled yearling bull from this cow for several good reasons.

We reserve the right to one flush from this animal to be agreed on with buyer.

### Lot 2 – GG32X – fullblood Bn Feb. 28

Another opportunity to buy into a heifer of which bloodline I am very interested in. This is an old bloodline. The sire, Mr. Sunnyview 23N (#7432), is a son of Beaufort George. The grandmother is the great cow Arrowhead Rosett that Ken Torkelson raised in the late 70's. Her dam, GG64P (Sire Capone son), has been an excellent cow for us. Min. Bid. \$1200

### Lot 3 – GG30X – fullblood Bn Feb. 27

Another rare opportunity on a unique pedigree. Her sire, Ibana, has not been used for decades. We own the semen bank on this bull. The breeder of Ibana, George Arthus is still breeding cattle in France and was breeder of the year 2 years ago. 30X is a big powerful heifer from GG70M, an excellent Dakota cow. \$1200

### Lot 4 – GG46X – fullblood Bn March 7

A super heifer calf from our Trojan bull which we sold for \$5000 to a commercial cattleman last spring. Her dam GG40T is from Semi Automatic from a Loulou cow. She has Loulou on both sides of her pedigree. Min. Bid. \$1200

### Lot 5 – GG42X – purebred black Bn March 5

Here is an interesting pedigree. She is sired by the fullblood bull, Manitou's Trojan and her mother GG68S is sired by the fullblood bull, Manitou's Newcomer (Loulou). This heifer is a high percentage purebred (99%) and still black. Breeders in the black Maines ought to look at this heifer and see what she can do for you. She has Loulou on both sides of her pedigree as well. Min. Bid. \$1200

Lot 6 – GG65X – purebred Bn March 16

A solid red purebred Palliser heifer from a 15 year old black Spees cow RRS42E. The dam of Palliser is 14 years old and very sound also. When you get longevity like this, it should be of interest to everyone. Min. Bid. \$1000

Lot 7 – GG44X – fullblood bull calf Bn March 6

Here is an opportunity to buy an excellent bull calf sired by the great Eden bull (#53). There is virtually no semen left on this bull. I cannot remember seeing a calf from him. The dam GG16R is sired by Loustic. Here is a mix of 2 bloodlines rarely used. We reserve half semen rights on this bull. Min. Bid. \$2500

Lot 8 – GG26W – bred purebred

A purebred Prospector heifer which we showed as a calf last fall. That should say something about her. Her dam GG11R (sire Kuda) is as good as they come. 11R comes out of our old Loulou cow 49G. 26W is a thick fleshy heifer. Exposed June 1 to GG64W. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 9 – GG29W – bred polled fullblood

Here is a very feminine polled fullblood heifer from a 2 year old MA44T (Sire Mr. Norman). Her granddam on the sire side is also damn of lot 1. AI'd to a light bw Angus bull May 11<sup>th</sup>, exposed to GG64W on June 1. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 10 – GG31W – bred fullblood

Another very feminine fullblood heifer. Her damn's first calf, a bull, weaned at 800lbs, also dam of Lot 7. She has an 80lb bw sired by the Newcomer bull, a super consistent son of Loulou. Her damn is from Loustic, an early import bull. Loustic on Loulous over the years produced super cattle. Bred May 18<sup>th</sup> to GG64W, exposed from June 1. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 11 – GG45W – bred fullblood

A Prospector heifer from the GG129N cow (sire Capone son). This cow has raised some real powerful calves. If you check out her pedigree, you will see a lot of excellent animals in it. The 45W heifer is a very smooth long bodied female. Bred May 30<sup>th</sup> to GG64W exposed June 1. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 12 – GG49W – bred fullblood

\*Different than in original sales catalogue\* DNA on 49W showed a different sire and damn; 2 cows switched calves at birth. 49W is a newcomer heifer from our excellent GG38P cow[ sire Capone son]. She is a good, thick & powerful female that will become an excellent cow. Bred May 4<sup>th</sup> GG64W, exposed June 1. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 13 – GG61W – bred fullblood

A fullblood Palliser heifer. Not too many of these. We used her picture last year in our advertising. The Palliser bull last year was sold to Montana. Her damn was Ms Gee Bar 430P, the pick of Glen Davidson's heifers and we recently sold her with a group of cows to Arkansas. Bred May 18<sup>th</sup> to GG64W, exposed June 1. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 14 – GG65W – bred fullblood

Another Palliser daughter. A 90lb bw. A very eye appealing heifer. Her damn GG99S is from the Bysantin son we used, and her mother was the MA4C cow that was superb. Bred May 7<sup>th</sup> to Manitou's Perelly, exposed Jun 1 to 64W. Min. Bid. \$1250

Lot 15 & 16 – Open half cross black heifers Bn Feb. 15 to Mar. 4

Here are 2 excellent heifer calves sired by a black Angus on our fullblood and purebred 2 year olds. They sell as a pair. The buyer has the option of taking another 5 heifer calves which we have at the same price. Min. Bid \$750 each We would like these heifers to be picked up by early September.
